SCHOOL REGULATIONS

TUITIONS

Enrollment for new students for the following academic year begins on the 1st of January. Registrations for Nursery and Pre-school are accepted throughout the academic year based on available vacancies; however, registrations can always be placed on a waiting list. In the event of enrollment cancellation or withdrawal from attendance, whether at the beginning or during the academic year, and regardless of the reason, no refund will be granted for any payment already made. The full payment for the current month remains due, along with any outstanding amounts.

All guardians, by signing the registration form, declare that they accept and respect the College School Regulations.

WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawals must be communicated by email to College management, at least 30 days in advance. This act does not imply the return of registration or outstanding monthly fees. If the withdrawal is not communicated within the aforementioned period, the monthly fees and other services will continue to be pending until communication is made.

MONTHLY FEES

The payment of monthly fees and other services is due by the 8th of each month. If they are not paid by the date mentioned above, they will incur a 10% increase on the total outstanding amount stated in the invoice. After this deadline, the student will not be allowed to attend the College until the situation has been resolved.

The month of July is paid in 10 monthly non-refundable installments.

During holiday periods (Christmas, Carnival and Easter) the payment of mandatory and optional monthly services does not change.

Any changes to student attendance conditions must be communicated 15 days before the beginning of each school term.

ABSENCES

A failure to attend school does not entitle any refund. Whenever a child is absent, the College must be informed.

The health and well-being of our students are of utmost importance to us, and we have measures in place to ensure they receive appropriate assistance if something happens during school hours.

When a child leaves school due to illness:

In the case of a fever: the child can return after 24 hours without a fever. In case of persistence, you will be contacted to pick up your child, and they can only return with medical authorization.

In cases of vomiting and diarrhea: the child can return the next day if there are no more symptoms. In case of persistence, you will be contacted to pick up your child, and they can only return with medical authorization.

Skin rashes or eye irritations: return with medical authorization.

In case of Pediculosis (head lice): Parents will be contacted to pick up the child and proceed with the necessary treatment.

If students are not properly dressed in the correct uniform, they will not be permitted to attend school. The uniform can be ordered at the school entrance by requesting an order sheet from a member of staff or by email to management.

We are not responsible for lost uniforms and uniforms without identification.

OPENING AND CLOSING HOURS

The School operates for Pre-school and Primary from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm.

For the Nursery: from 8:30 am to 5:30 pm.

Extended hours are available only for Pre-school and Primary – from 5:30 pm to 6:00 pm.

Teaching Hours:

Nursery: 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

Pre-school: 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

Primary: 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

After 5:30 pm, only pupils enrolled in the extended hours provision may remain on the school premises. Otherwise, an ad hoc extended hours fee will be charged, in accordance with the rate set in the fee schedule for each academic year, per hour or part thereof.

The School reserves the right to close its services whenever circumstances justify it, namely in cases of epidemics, natural disasters, or other situations that prevent the normal operation of the School, in order to safeguard the health and well-being of the children and staff.

TOYS AND GAMES

The school is not responsible for any toys, games or other personal belongings that children bring from home.

NAPTIME

Children take a nap up to and including 3 year olds.

FIELD TRIPS

The Christmas Theatre, visits to the Zoo, End of Year trip for finalists, End of the Year school trip and Christmas Circus are not considered as field trips.
